It emphasized that menstrual hygiene is a matter of human rights and highlighted the significant health risks, educational impediments, and limited opportunities resulting from inadequate access to menstrual products, education, and sanitation facilities, underscoring the need for collective action to ensure no one is left behind due to this natural biological process
